

The Kenan Center Campus & Programs

Facilities on the Kenan Center campus include a sports arena, a converted carriage-house theater and community gathering room, an education building, outdoor recreational fields, playground, and the Kenan house, an 1800's Victorian mansion featuring a year-round art gallery, gift shop and formal gardens. Mrs. Kenan's restored sitting room, also known as the Ladies' Parlor, presents visitors with a glimpse into life at the turn-of-the-century.

The Kenan Center provides a variety of educational experiences for all ages that includes Lifelong Learning Classes, a Nursery School, tours and special programs related to the admission-free Kenan Center House Gallery, and a variety of programs presented by our affiliate groups: the Kenan Arts Council, Kenan Quilters' Guild, and Friends of the Kenan Herb Club. The Kenan Arena houses numerous sports and recreational programs including one of the largest indoor youth soccer programs in Western New York, a growing high school lacrosse program, soccer and football clinics, and adult soccer and volleyball. It is also the site of annual special events such as the Kenan Center's regionally acclaimed *100 American Craftsmen* show which celebrates the "art of craft."

The Kenan Center also plays a prominent role as a regional arts and culture provider, offering on-school-time performances to school students, and providing string instruction to elementary students through a partnership with the Lockport City School District. The Kenan Center is also a geocache site on the Great Lakes Seaway Trail—a wonderful way to enjoy the adventure of "treasure hunting," and the beautiful Kenan campus! 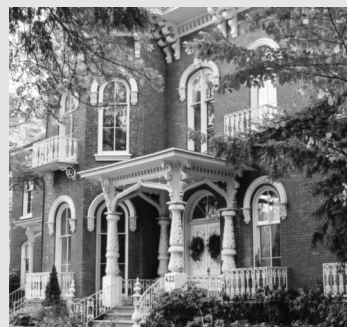
